Sunflowers from Coast to Coast

In the past year, Celebrate Planet Earth has reached 7732 elementary classrooms across the country with live caterpillars and sunflower seeds. These engaging kits allow children to observe the remarkable metamorphosis of butterflies and learn about the growth of sunflowers. By putting nature into the hands of children, we ignite their curiosity and instill a sense of responsibility towards the natural world.

Our Partnership with International Paper

With the support of International Paper's Community Engagement Program, we distributed Butterfly and Sunflower Classroom Kits to 5206 classrooms selected by 108 International Paper mills and recycling facilities.

Our New Mexico Classrooms

Our dedicated program in Northern New Mexico provided Butterfly and Sunflower Kits to 200 HeadStart and elementary classrooms, along with 14 educational classroom visits from our staff. By combining the kits with interactive learning experiences, we created meaningful impact on children in our local community.

After 33 years, Celebrate Planet Earth's beloved founder **Clifford Lewis Ross**, aka Mister Cliff, has retired as Executive Director and has transitioned to the Board of Directors as the Director of Play.
